Hiking and camping on Arrernte country along the Larapinta Trail from Alice Springs to Mount Sonder, I was able to immerse and absorb the experience fully, via all the senses, until it felt that the spirit in the land became the same spirit within me.

Back in the studio with great reverence and sensitivity, I embarked on making what was seen and experienced, visible again. The landscape is instantly recognisable; however, the tone of the paintings indicates that they have come from the inside, not out. The work is about feeling, and the process of painting, is my way of unpacking, maintaining, and nurturing a relationship with that beautiful desert land.
